GOLF BENEFICIARIES





On March 15, 2023, GoVo District enjoyed the realization of a goal long in the works when it celebrated the Grand Opening of the Free as a Bird Skatepark. This program was led by the young people of GuVo and began back in 2017 when a group of GuVo young people created a skateboarding group called Endure. This group of young leaders would go on to present their skatepark plan to GuVo District and Youth Councils, Tucson Skatepark Alliance, and the Tony Hawk Foundation.

On November 12, 2020, Endure was awarded a grant of \$20,000.00 for skatepark construction by The Skatepark Project of the Tony Hawk Foundation and Portugal The Man (PTM) Foundation. They would go on to secure a second grant for the skatepark and lead a community cleanup day where materials were recycled as a fundraiser. While the COVID pandemic hampered construction, causing a delay of nearly two years, the community and program's generous stakeholders were able to preserve and continue to move the project forward.

In April of 2022 the grounds were able to be prepped for the long anticipated skatepark build, and by October of 2022 the call went out for volunteers to assist with clearing construction debris in preparation for the final stages of construction. Concrete was poured in November 2022, and while it was originally envisioned that the park would open before the end of 2022, there was an opportunity to include local Indigenous mural artists who designed original artwork for the space which pushed back the grand opening. While the postponement was less than ideal, it did also allow each Community Council in the District to contribute a total of five traditional shade ramadas to the project.

The Grand Opening of the "Free As A Bird Skatepark" in GuVo took place on March 15, 2023. The event represented a culmination of a vision that began in 2017 with nearly 200 members of the community and visiting dignitaries on hand to show their support by taking part in the Grand Opening festivities. Since then, NAAF has worked on installing tables and chairs; trash receptacles; a bike rack; outdoor grills and bleachers to make the outdoor grounds more community friendly,

Additionally, NAAF was able to secure support to purchase a portable skatepark. This new portable resource will allow NAAF to rotate in individual mobile components, such as quarter pipes, launch ramps, grind rails, etc., at the Free as a Bird skatepark to ensure it remains new and vital, as well as set up temporary "pop-up" skateparks for several weeks at a time both within the District and at locations outside the District. Finally, the Free as a Bird skatepark held its first Skate Competition on 12/3/2023. This was not just an event for skaters in GuVo but was open to competitors from across the Tohono O'odham Nation.

This is just one of the latest developments in NAAF's ongoing Prevention efforts to promote games and sports as an important part of improving the health and well-being among local youth. The gradual shift to a more sedentary lifestyle has resulted in poor health outcomes and highlighted the need to reawaken interest in physical activity. NAAF already formally supports activities that focus on fitness, wellness, and positive recreational activities for the District's youth, including a Unity Run; establishing a We R1 Basketball team and recently securing support to revitalize an existing baseball/softball diamond in the District.













Gold Classic Beneficiary: TONCA Foundation 2024 Update

O'odham residents at the Archie Hendricks Sr. Skilled Nursing Facility and the Tohono O'odham Elder Assisted Living Residence have enjoyed enhanced activities thanks to the Golf Classic. These activities allow residents to socialize, have fun, and spend time doing new and entertaining things, which help improve mood and overall wellbeing.

During National Assisted Living Week, residents went out to the movies and out to eat. They had cookie making days, a day of pet therapy, and had their favorite food delivered from Whataburger.

Because residents were unable to attend Elders Day at the Casino, the Residence created an Elders Day Watch Party thanks to the TONCA Media Team who attended at the casino and filmed live on the TONCA YouTube Channel. The Watch Party was decorated with balloons and special table settings for a catered lunch and snacks. Residents also received corsages. One resident was honored for turning 90 at the actual event, and when the residents heard her name, everybody cheered.

TONCA helped bring a community screening of the Native film "Touch the Water" and residents were taken to the event. The screening was festive, with decorations and movie inspired snacks like popcorn and nachos. Approximately 100 people attended, including 25 community members. Residents received autographed posters of the film too.

In November, TONCA celebrated its 20th anniversary of the Nursing Facility and the 10th anniversary of the Elder Residence. The event was very special as family and friends of the residents attended. It was an exciting and fun-filled day, concluding with dancing and fireworks. Almost 400 people participated including residents, staff, and 300 family and community members.

Thanks to the support from the Golf Classic residents have benefited from "field trips" to movies, restaurants, and shopping centers. They have had more arts and crafts activities to celebrate holidays, birthdays, and other special occasions. A significant highlight was the "Parade of Lights" at Christmastime which was open to the community and family members.

Finally, with the support of the Golf Classic, the TONCA Foundation has been able to provide residents with more supplies and physical activity games and activities to keep residents motivated and engaged with each other. Super-sized "Connect 4", "Pong Toss" and "Bean Bag Toss" are favorites and residents get very competitive while having fun. There are approximately 40 residents in nursing home throughout the year.

Guided by O'odham Himdag: To provide comprehensive services in order to achieve an improved state of physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual well being.

Mission Statement of the Division of Senior Services

The mission of the Division of Senior Services is to enhance the quality of life for Tohono O'odham elderly and disabled adults by identifying, developing and providing quality services.

The Division of Senior Services on one of eight divisions under the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). DHHS is a branch of the Executive Office of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

DHHS Senior Services established through the 1964 Older American Act. DHHS Senior Services continues to provide

- Elder Nutrition Services services include congregate meals in 10 center across the Tohono O'odham Nation and home delivered meals to our homebound elders
- Resources and Activities Program services include activities during congregate meals i.e. hands-on workshops, nutrition education, organizing field trips, informational presentations and organizing holiday parties with other Elder Centers.
- Caregiver Support Services services include support, education, advocacy and client support to unpaid/informal caregivers. Caregivers who out of the kindness of their heart are caring for a family member, neighbor or friend.
- Adult Care Services assists in applying for Arizona Long Term Care Services (ALTCS). Case Managers provide
 advocacy and support to those applying for ALTCS. Case Manager Aids provide homemakers services to elders who
 need minimal assistance in their homes. Light chores, light cooking and non-medical transportation are provided.
- Arizona Long Term Care Systems (ALTCS) eligible members receive case management services through our ALTCS program.
- Ombudsman Services advocate services provided to O'odham members residing in a skilled nursing facility, adult day care or assisted living.

Services through grant and tribal funding to support the following programs:

Senior Services serves 55 and over, disabled, mentally challenged adults – living on and off the Tohono O'odham Nation. Congregate, home delivered meals, and socialization activities are provided in the following districts:

• Vava Chin

Schuk Toak

• San Xavier

Gu Achi

• Chukuk Kut

• Sif Oidak

• Gu Vo

• Pisinemo

• San Lucy

As a beneficiary of the Desert Diamond Annual Gold Classic, Senior Services will use funding to expand and create a larger congregate dining room for our Elders, located in Sells, at the Management of Health building.

A larger dining room allows Elders to dine, socialize and participate in activities safely. Elders will also participate in field trips to various local attractions, participate in holiday celebrations organized by Senior Services and Elder Center Coordinators and participate in hands-on activities with funding provided.
